

ORDINANCE NO. 1033.

An ordinance prohibiting the dancing in the City of Santa Cruz of dances commonly known as the "Turkey Trot", "Texas Tommy", "Grizzly Bear", "Bunny Hug" and all other dances similar in character and all dances commonly known as "ragging".

Be it ordained by the City of Santa Cruz, as follows;

SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful, after this ordinance goes into effect, for any person to dance or participate in the dancing, at any public gathering or assemblage, in the City of Santa Cruz, of any of the dances commonly known as the "Turkey Trot", "Texas Tommy", "Grizzly Bear", "Bunny Hug" or any other dances similar in character to said dances or any dances commonly known as "ragging".

SECTION 2. It shall be unlawful, after this ordinance goes into effect, for any person, firm or corporation to permit any person to dance or participate in the dancing of any of the dances commonly known as the "Turkey Trot", "Texas Tommy", "Grizzly Bear", "Bunny Hug" or any other dances similar in character to said dances or any of the dances commonly known as "ragging" at any public gathering or assemblage held in any building or upon any floor in the City of Santa Cruz, over which building or floor such person, firm or corporation shall have or exercise control.

SECTION 3. Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof, shall be punished by a fine of not more than One Hundred (100) Dollars, or by imprisonment in the City Jail for a period of not to exceed thirty (30) days or by both such fine and imprisonment.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall be in force and take effect from and after thirty (30) days after its passage and approval and the publication thereof once in the SANTA CRUZ SURF.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall be published five times in the SANTA CRUZ SURF a daily newspaper of general circulation, printed, published and circulated in the City of Santa Cruz.
